Volunteer Citizen Emergency Responders

A small group of Residents gathered in June to discuss a shared interest in "re-igniting" a safety program here at the Lake that had went, somewhat, dormant the past few years. The goal of the Responders is to respond in the initial phases after a call to 911 is made, in the case of a missing person or an emergency on the water. If such an event should occur, this group will be notified by the Pow. Co. Sheriff Dispatch and will then follow an outlined practice established by the group.



A couple of meetings were held to learn about the historical practice, then discuss and establish the current procedure for the Volunteer group. A member from both the Poweshiek County Sheriff's Department and True Security were present at the initial meetings, offering their individual insights and suggestions. A MOCK-RUN "trial-run" was held August 4 and went very well.

Thank you to all who participated in this year's Poker Run! There were a total of 414 entries. We spent \$9,100.00 to put on the event and profited \$6,500.00. Yet another successful fundraiser to stock fish in our lake this fall. Stay tuned for stocking numbers this spring!

Be a Master Angler! The Iowa DNR has a Mast Angler Award Program. The Iowa Master Angler Award recognizes memorable-sized catches for more than 40 species of fish. Anglers who apply and qualify receive an official frameable certificate and decal. On top of the Master Angler Award, they also have Species Specialist, Silver Master Angler and Golf Master Angler awards for multiple master anglers or multiple masters of the same species. Fish must meet the minimum species length and verified by a witness. The fish can be released and still qualify for an award. Its easy and FREE! Here are some of the minimum lengths for the species in our lake for the program:

Large Mouth Bass......20"

Bullhead15"

Crappie.....14"

Muskie.....45"

Perch......12"




Holiday Lake RIZ Committee

RIZ is looking forward to observing the DINO Six mini dredge removing sediment in the south 600 ft of Hap's Cove after Labor Day. Please note that when the dredging starts, there will be limited access for boats on lifts due to the dredge cable dissecting the cove. The project is targeted to be completed in November.



This dredge is a small trailerable dredge with a horizontal auger that is winched along cables set up in a "H" pattern. The cables will be secured with a metal stake/plate securement system or a nylon strap around a tree.




We have asked that lot owners remove their docks and boat lifts as this provides the best access to all of the sediment. However, when docks and boat lifts are left in the lake, the dredge will be pulled along the outside.



RIZ will make available our Piranha mini dredge to lot owners as a DIY project to remove sediment around docks and boat lifts not removed.
