# Scuba Club Update

Recent rains have resulted in low visibility. However, members are actively searching the coves for the Curly Leaf Pond Weed that was recently discovered in Ford's Cove. Any plants found will be removed and the location reported to the office. The HOA recently provided the following description:

It is an invasive, rooted, submersed aquatic plant with coloration varying from olive-green to reddish-brown. The leaves are wavy, lasagna-like and the plant can grow up to 15 feet tall.

Curly-leaf pondweed impacts:

- \* Dense mats at the water's surface inhibit water recreationists.
- \* Overtakes habitat and outcompetes native aquatic plants, potentially lowering *diversity*.
- \* *Provides unsuitable shelter, food, and nesting habitat for native animals.*
- \* *Midsummer die-offs can litter the shoreline with dead plants.*

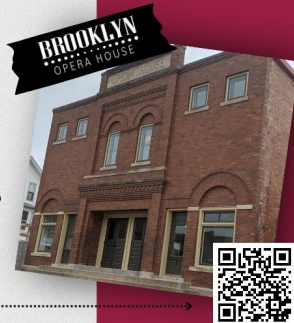

## Fish Committee Update

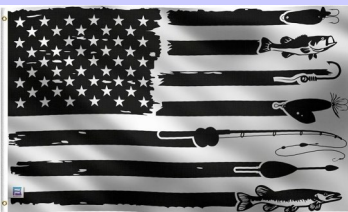

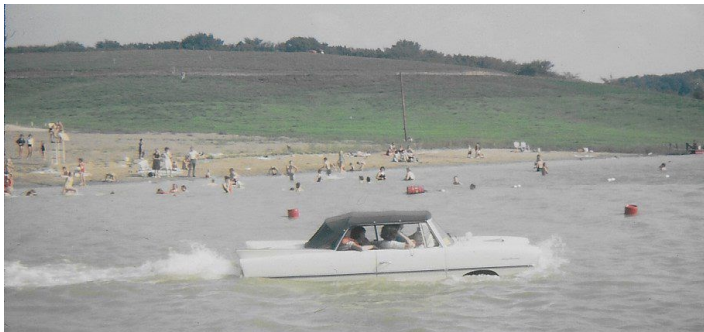


# Holiday Lake History

The **Amphicar Model 770** is an amphibious automobile which was launched at the 1961 New York Auto Show. It was made in West Germany and marketed from 1961 to 1968, with production ceasing in 1965.

Designed by Hans Trippel, the amphibious vehicle was manufactured by the Quandt Group at Lübeck and at Berlin-Borsigwalde, with a total of 3,878 manufactured in a single generation. The name Amphicar is a portmanteau of "amphibious" and "car."

The Betterment Committee has completed 2 of 3 approved 2024 projects.



The Office Entrance was given a facelift! Very simple vintage elements were added to the grounds, while repurposing another. We attempted to keep this area simple to fit in with the Maintenance grounds in which it resides. The Powell Park sign was also given a more prominent face by simply adding landscape edgers and river rock.

We plan to begin work on the 3rd project after the 4th of July holiday weekend. [Installing a Holiday Lake sign at the South Entrance]



It is our hope to be able to install 1-2 Sunshades at Powell Park [over the 2 benches along N. Lakeshore DJ]. The Committee has proposed the idea to the Board of Directors. We have further details and information to bring forward for approval or denial.
