



Holiday Lake RIZ Committee Update

Holiday Lake – Rural Improvement Zone 2025 Dredging Projects. The following information is provided for your planning purposes.

Order of Work:

2025: Dredge Ford's and Don's Coves using a silt basin at the ends of each cove.

Dredger will commence at the NE shoreline of Ford's Cove, continuing S, then up the W side of Ford's Cove, then to the E shore of Don's Cove, then N along the W side of Don's Cove.

2026: Dredge Ike's Cove using the silt basin north of Andy's pond.

Dredger will commence on the NW Shoreline of Ike's Cove, continuing S to the S boat dock, then N along the W shoreline.

Scheduling:

Contractor will have access to lake property for tube assembly after August 18th.

Dredging to begin after Labor Day (September 1st)

Launching the dredger will occur from the north boat ramp adjacent to the beach.

Dredger will operate Monday through Thursday (4 days per week)

The Lake will provide silt basins at the ends of For's and Don's coves for the silt.

Docks and boatlifts:

Removal is optional, but the RIZ recommends getting them out of the way if you want the silt removed underneath.

If the dock and lifts are out of the way, the dredger can get within approximately 4 ft of the shoreline.

RIZ trustees are aware of at least one service that can assist in moving docks/lifts.

Family Marine 515-322-1462 Jeff Delvaux (this is at lot owner's cost)

Mini-Dredge:

Silt closer to shore (or under your docks and lifts) can be removed prior September $1^{\rm st}$

RIZ has a min-dredge available, <u>first-come-first-served</u>

Only labor cost to the lot owner

Priority use for Ford's and Don's Cove owners.

Complete mini-dredging before September 1st.

So the large dredge can clean up the silt as it passes by your property

Big dredge's path is behind lifts (20+ ft. from shoreline)

Safety: Dredge tube will be in use while dredging CAUTION IS REQUIRED. Dredging tube will be marked with orange buoys or flashing lights. You can expect tube running from dredge to the end of the cove being dredged.

Emergency Preparedness Update

A suggestion offered at the Emergency Preparedness Event held on May 31 and discussed at the Emergency Volunteer Responders meeting on June 6, will now be implemented.

Should there be an emergency on the lake/water [medical issue, boating, swimming accident, etc] where 911 has been called, the Dispatcher will ask you for your location. Many folks will not be able to respond with a specific location, name of a cove, or what boat ramp they are near. Being able to visualize a Unit number and Lot on the end of a near-by dock, will assist the Volunteers and EMS responders to the ramp nearest the incident.

Residents living on the shoreline may volunteer to post a metal sign on the end of their dock, with their respective unit and lot number. [i.e. My address is: 5019] The sign will mimic that of a 911 sign. It will be blue with REFLECTIVE white/silver numbers. The cost is \$28 [4.5" x 17"] and can be ordered at AMAYzing Signs. [formerly Signs by Fisher] Call Thom May today to order yours! 641-522-7850.
